The team is currently working on smaller preparatory projects for the go-kart race, now in week three of development. Mesa College would be the first community college to participate in this competition. Materials are costly, and while they have acquired a used go-kart, it requires repairs. They are seeking secondhand parts to reduce expenses and aim to bring hands-on robotics opportunities to campus. Most participating students are STEM majors, with some business majors involved. Meetings are held weekly on Fridays in person.
